This week's update:

Survey Work - Ariston Site

Herts County Council has commissioned further survey work of the Ariston site and in particular the Heathlands Drive area. Works started earlier this week and should complete shortly. This commission is part of HCC's work to complete the mapping of their site.

Investigation Works - Fontmell Area

We still expect to receive results at the end of February or beginning of March. There might be a slight delay as some further tests are being carried out on soil samples taken from the area. We will continue to keep you updated with any progress and will discuss the results with all residents as soon as we are able to.

Utilities

We understand that some equipment from utility companies still remains on site. We are chasing this up with the relevant companies to try and get it cleared up.

Lighting

The new lighting rig has now been installed on site. This should be slightly quieter than the previous rig but will still be as effective.

We have also been informed that the cone lights have not been working properly. We have raised this with Amey and they will replace the batteries in the next few days.
